Purpose	This policy guides the wearing of student uniforms and dress in accordance with Christian principles of modesty and neatness.
Authority	School Constitution - Powers and Duties of School Committee Education Act: Regulation 189a on school dress code;
Policy	The wearing of a school uniform is compulsory for students in Yrs. 7 -10 and shall promote an appropriate and consistent standard of dress. The wearing of a uniform is optional in K-6. Where the uniform is not worn, the dress standards will reflect Christian standards of neatness and modesty.

Student Uniform Procedure

The Principal, in conjunction with the School Committee, and in consultation with parents, adopt a uniform covering different circumstances within the school program, which is binding on all students in year 7-10 and optional in the Primary School.

Students wearing a school uniform show thereby that they belong to and represent a student body with a distinctively Reformed ethos. It gives the school a unique identity and creates a sense of equity for all students. The uniform must be well-fitting, clean and in good repair.

Students are to wear the correct uniform to and from school and while they are at school. Except for some camps or excursions, they shall wear the correct uniform to all off-campus school activities.

Parents may seek an exemption from the school uniform for medical reasons supported by a doctor's statement.

Students not wearing the school uniform, unless exempted, will receive notice and parents may be contacted to correct this situation. Parents must contact the school if there are extra-ordinary circumstances preventing students wearing the school uniform on a particular day.

The school uniform includes:

Girls:

- Maroon Tartan Pleated Skirt
- Blue Banded Shirt or unisex shirt – short or long sleeves
- Maroon Knitted Jumper
- Blue Socks or navy Tights
- Black Lace-up Leather Shoes
- Navy Scarf

Boys:

- Navy Shorts or Navy Long Pants
- Blue Unisex Shirt – short or long sleeves
- Maroon Knitted Jumper
- Navy Socks
- Black Lace-up Leather Shoes

Sport:

- Maroon/navy Polo Shirt
- Navy Active Shorts
- Maroon slouch hat

Slouch hats are required outside in terms 1 & 4.

Final judgement regarding school uniform matters remains with the principal.



Dress Code:

In addition to the school uniform, the following dress code guidelines shall be observed:

- All clothing must be neat and reflect Christian values.
- Offensive slogans, graphics or pictures and denim is not permitted.
- Wearing of sensible footwear is encouraged, e.g. school shoes or sandals.
- Girls are permitted to wear one fine necklace, one bracelet, one ring and one small pair of ear rings.
- Hair colouring should be kept as close to the students' natural colour as possible.
- Boys are not permitted to wear any jewelry, except for medical purposes.
- Noticeable cosmetics and make-up will not be permitted.
- For year 7-10 students, permission must be obtained to arrive and depart from school out of the school uniform.
- Swimwear must be modest.
